
## **Economics 172:** Issues in African Economic Development Problem Set 4 (Due in class Thursday May 6, 2004)

## 1. Nation-building in East Africa – 5 points

- (a) Contrast post-independence public policy in Kenya versus Tanzania in terms of: i) language policies, ii) civic education, iii) local government reform. (Discuss in approximately one paragraph for each).
- (b) Based on your reading of Barkan (1994), Laitin (1992), Miguel (2003), and on lecture, do you think the nation-building "package" adopted by Tanzania in the post-independence period is a realistic policy option for other African countries, like Kenya, today? (Discuss in at most one double-spaced page.)

## 2. Per Capita Income and Civil Conflict – 5 points

Consider the following figure, which presents the negative relationship between per capita income levels (in logs) and the likelihood of civil conflict for 43 Sub-Saharan African countries during 1981-1999. (Each data point is a country observation.)



- (a) Provide two distinct, causal interpretations for the observed negative relationship.
- (b) Briefly discuss the micro-empirical evidence on causal impacts of conflict on economic conditions in Mozambique, as described in Dreze (2000). (In 2-3 paragraphs)
- (c) If you could design a household survey to collect data in a *post-conflict* society (say, in Sierra Leone), which three (3) questions would you most like to ask *individuals*, in order to assess the impact of the conflict on economic growth and development? Write out the questions exactly as you would want them included on the survey form.
